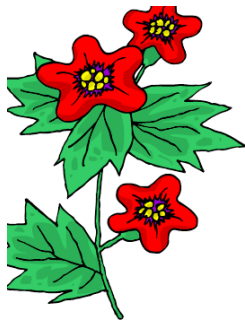


UPCOMING EVENTS
