There will be no Communion on Sunday, April 2. Please join us on Easter Sunday to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus and share in the Lord's Supper.

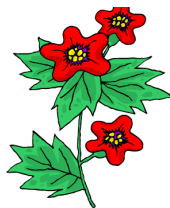
