Minister Search Update - The Search Committee has made significant progress in recent weeks in its efforts to find the next minister to lead Dearborn Congregational Church. After 9 months of screening ministerial applicants and conducting interviews, the committee has narrowed the field of candidates to one individual in particular who the Committee believes is the right fit for our congregation. Members should be alert to the possibility of a call to attend a general meeting to vote on the committee's choice for the new pastor. Stay tuned for an announcement about a potential July meeting date.

Pentecost Sunday, June 8 - The second Sunday in June is Pentecost Sunday. To observe the occasion marking the birth of the Christian church, we ask everyone attending the service that day to wear something red. In addition, the Diaconate will host a special coffee hour afterwards and plans to bring an assortment of delicious treats, including a large cake!

We will be visiting Old St. Mary's Roman Catholic Church in the Greektown district and Old St. John's / St. Luke's Church UCC in the Eastern Market district.

they prefer) downtown to Old St. Mary's for an 11:00 am tour lasting about 45 minutes. The suggested donation is \$2 per person. Then we will head over to our second stop, Old St. John's.
