Aren't you glad we can experience the joy of Easter? But first, we must move behind the joyful celebration of Palm Sunday that will lead us through the shadows of Good Friday and take us to an empty tomb and a risen Savior. I love Palm Sunday celebrations because I know where the journey ends!

A Palm Sunday Prayer: I worship you Lord! You did not enter your holy city Jerusalem on the back of a war horse, but humbly and on a donkey. You knew that you were surrounded by murderers, yet you came in peace, and by your sacrifice you would conquer death. You, oh Lord, are blessed and worthy of my praise. You have saved your people. You are my King and I long to live in the city where you sit on the throne. I will sing your praises until your Kingdom comes and is established. Amen.
